## Goals & Activities



### **Public Opinion Research and Analysis**

Impacting Futures conducts research and analysis across all 50 states to better understand the key issues facing early childhood, along with supporting other polling and state-level analysis.



### **Strategic Engagement, Implementation, and Technical Assistance**

Impacting Futures will engage with key state partners and organizations to build out policy analysis teams and partner with philanthropic leaders to advance the mission. Impacting Futures prepares and supports communication packages, materials, and provides strategic guidance as needed to further the mission.



### **Communications Support**

Impacting Futures works aggressively to support and amplify the message of helping and protecting young children and families, insofar that we support the following: developing annual reports, worksheets, and policy briefs, supporting paid and earned media, and elevating prior successes.



### **Convening**

Impacting Futures convenes two in-person and two virtual forums, with key stakeholders who have a personal investment in young children and families, allowing for peer-to-peer idea sharing among leaders in different states. Impacting Futures regularly assesses the short and long term plans, and thereby the needs of key states to set forth the strategic direction over the next one to five years.
